The topic

A world where a billion people are deprived, insecure and vulnerable is an unsafe world. The separation between domestic and international health problems is losing its usefulness as people and goods travel across continents. This scenario lead to spread of the infectious pathogens; zoonotic diseases which holds back development and weakens societies. Food safety is a serious public health concern in the world's populous countries including India wherein 13.2% of households reported food-borne illness. Antimicrobial resistance (AMR) has emerged as one of the principal public health problems of the 21st century that threatens the effective prevention and treatment of an ever-increasing range of infections. Environmental issues have their own priorities and change in seasonal variation has led to rise in new vector population and thus emergence-reemergence of the pathogens has created new challenges .

Apart from the discussions on the various issues the platform will also act as forum for exchange of the research thoughts among the scientists and academicians of national and international repute in various fields of public health, microbiology, molecular epidemiology, diagnostics, environmental issues, food safety and animal welfare.

The Association

The Indian Association of Public Health Specialists (IAVPHS) was established on 3rd May, 1997. The association focuses on broad fields of Veterinary Public Health including food safety, zoonoses, environmental hygiene, comparative pathology, biomedicine and related public health fields. It has been organizing Annual conference and National Symposium since 2002. Till now 15 such conferences have been organized. The proposed national conference & the symposium has focused its interest in areas like Food safety and Security, Antimicrobial Resistance, Zoonoses, Animal Welfare, Community Medicine and Environmental Health .

About Nagpur

Nagpur is the second capital and the third largest city of the Indian state of Maharashtra. Presently it has prime project under Niche Area of Excellence funded by ICAR on "Centre for Zoonoses".

About Centre for Zoonoses

The Niche Area of Excellence Program on 'Centre for Zoonoses' has been sanctioned by ICAR, New Delhi. It is equipped with state of the art facilities such as MALDI-TOF, Vitek 2, BacT Alert, Biosafety cabinets (Class II B2), Sonicator, ELISA reader, automated Gram staining



machine, Inverted microscope, Dark field microscope, Fluorescent microscope etc. The Centre with its medical collaborators is actively engaged in research activities on zoonotic diseases viz., Leptospirosis, Brucellosis, Listeriosis, Tuberculosis, Scrub Typhus and Rota viral infection. It also undertakes capacity building program
